Level 3 (International Judge) - \$8.00

Judging Requirements

- A. Level 1 Judge (14-15 years old): This judge may be a corner judge for color belt competition. Judges are required to be 14-15 years of age and a 1st Degree Black Belt or higher rank. A judge 14-15 years old, may only judge competitors 15 and under, while under the supervision of two judges, ages 16 or older.
- B. Level 2 Judge (16 years and older): This judge may be a center judge for colored belt competition and a corner judge for black belt competition. Judges must be 16 years of age or older and a 1st Degree Black Belt or higher rank.
- C. Level 3 Judge (18 years and older): This judge may be center judge in black belt competition. The judge must be 18 years of age or older and a 2nd Degree Black Belt or higher rank.

Note: **"YOU NEED TO STUDY THE RULES BEFORE THE CLINIC"**.
Certification requires passing a written test with a minimum score of 80% and payment of the appropriate certification fee. Once a person has reached the maximum level for their age and rank requirement, they will be required to re-certify annually - at no cost.

Additional Requirements

White uniforms are required dress. All certified instructors, trainee and junior instructors, and black belt students of all ages are qualified to attend a tournament judge certification seminar. Any junior black belt may take the certification test 6 months before their 14th birthday, however must wait until they are 14 to place the Level 1 chevron on their uniform. All other younger black belt may participate in simulated competition while qualified black belts practice judging. Anyone testing for Level 1 certification will be required to know all colored belt forms through Red/Black Belt and all one-step sparring combinations through High-Yellow Belt.
